ATV-UTV Ordinance

Amending Town of Pine Lake ATV-UTV Ordinance adopted January 15, 2014 and effective May 31, 2014. And Amended June 15, 2016.

The Town Board of the Town of Pine Lake pursuant to its authority under s.23.33(8)(b) and (11), Wis. stats., does hereby amend the Town of Pine Lake ATV-UTV Ordinance and Amendment and does ordain as follows:

1. Section V-Designation of All-Terrain Vehicle [and Utility Terrain Vehicle] Routes is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

Pursuant to 23.33(8) Wis. Stats, all town roads in the Town of Pine Lake, except N. Birchwood Drive, W. Birchwood Drive and Lonely Drive, are designated as All-Terrain Vehicle [and Utility Terrain Vehicle] routes.

All designated routes as stated above will be open year round for use except River Road (from County W to Eagles Bluff Road) and Forest Lane which will be closed during Hodag Countryfest – dates to be determined by the town board each year.


This amendment will be effective upon publication/posting and signage being put in place.




1. Section V-Designation of All-Terrain Vehicle [and Utility Terrain Vehicle] Routes is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:



ATV-UTV Ordinance

SECTION I – TITLE AND PURPOSE

The title of this ordinance is the Town of Pine Lake All-Terrain Vehicle[and Utility Terrain Vehicle] Route Ordinance. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] routes in the town and to regulate the operation of all-terrain vehicles [and utility terrain vehicles] in the town.

SECTION II – AUTHORITY

The Town Board of the Town of Pine Lake, Oneida County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority to adopt this All-Terrain Vehicle [and Utility Terrain Vehicle] Ordinance under s. [23.33 \(8\) \(b\)](#) and [\(11\)](#), Wis. stats.

SECTION III – ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

This ordinance adopted on proper notice with a quorum and roll call vote by a majority of the town board present and voting, provides the authority for the town to designate all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] routes in the town and to regulate the use of those routes and all-terrain vehicles [and utility terrain vehicles] in the town, designates all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] routes in the town and provides for the regulation of the use of those routes and of all-terrain vehicles [and utility terrain vehicles] in the town.

SECTION IV – OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES [AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLES]

Pursuant to s. [23.33 \(4\) \(d\) 4.](#), Wis. stats., except as otherwise provided in s. [23.33 \(4\)](#), Wis. stats., no person may operate an all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] on the roadway portion of any highway in the town except on roadways that are designated as all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] routes by this ordinance. Operation of all-terrain vehicles [and utility terrain vehicles] on a roadway in the town that is an all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] route is authorized only for the extreme right side of the roadway remaining on blacktop at all times except that left turns may be made from any part of the roadway that is safe given prevailing conditions.

SECTION V – DESIGNATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE [AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE] ROUTES

Pursuant to [23.33\(8\)](#) Wis. Stats, the following routes are designated as seasonal all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] routes in the town that will be open from December 1 till April 1 of each year:

- Bass Lake Loop - All
- Bissonette Lane - All

- Iroquois Ct - All
- Manor Road - All
- Manor Loop - All
- Mohawk Road - All
- Mohawk Shores Dr - All
- Moon Lite Bay Road - All
- Nature Road - All
- North Bay Road - All
- Orchard Dr - All
- Penny Lane - All
- River View Dr - All
- Sandy Bluff Road - All
- Silent Dr - All
- Spur Lane - All
- Squirrel Dr - All
- Trails End Road - North Bay Road to south dead end
- Trails End Loop Road - All
- Woodland Drive - All
- Wood Park Dr - All

Pursuant to 23.33(8) Wis. Stats, the following routes are designated as year round all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] routes in the town.

- Candlelite Lane - All
- Cross Country Road - Pine Lake Road to Stella Town Line
- Headquarters TR - All
- Lake Shore Drive - CTH C to Stella Town Line
- Limberlost Road - Woodland Drive to Stella Town Line
- Moen Lake Road - All
- Port Aurora Road - All
- Pine Lake Road -Cross Country Road to Sugar Camp Town Line
- Ridge Road - All
- Rocky Road - All
- Roosevelt Road - Lake Shore Dr to Stella Town Line
- Sandy Beach Road - All
- Shady Lane - Lakeshore Dr to Lakeshore Dr
- South Pine Lake Lane - All



## SECTION VI – CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE [AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE] ROUTES

Pursuant to s. 23.33 (8) (d), Wis. stats., the following restrictions are placed on the use of the town all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] routes designated by this resolution:

A. Routes shall be marked with uniform all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] route signs in accordance with s. NR 64.12 (7), Wisconsin Administrative Code. No person may do any of the following in regard to signs marking town all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] routes:

1. Intentionally remove, damage, deface, move, or obstruct any uniform all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] route or trail sign or standard or intentionally interfere with the effective operation of any uniform all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] route or trail sign or standards if the sign or standard is legally placed by the state, any municipality, or any authorized individual.
2. Possess any uniform all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] route or trail sign or standard of the type established by the department for the warning, instruction, or information of the public, unless he or she obtained the uniform all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] route or trail sign or standard in a lawful manner. Possession of a uniform all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] route or trail sign or standard creates a rebuttable presumption of illegal possession.

B. Operation shall be subject to all provisions of s. 23.33, Wis. stats., which is adopted as a part of this ordinance by reference, pursuant to s. 23.33 (11), Wis. stats.

C. A copy of this ordinance shall be sent by the town clerk to the Department of Natural Resources, the Oneida County Sheriff's Department and any other law enforcement agency serving the Town of Pine Lake's jurisdiction.

D. Additional restrictions :

1. All all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] operators shall observe posted ATV speed limits of 35 MPH (specific areas may be posted at 25 MPH).
2. All all-terrain vehicle [and utility terrain vehicle] operators shall ride single file.
3. ATV operators on approved Town of Pine Lake ATV Routes must be a minimum of 16 years of age.
4. ATV safety certificate is required if born after January 1, 1988.
5. Headgear - No person may operate or be a passenger on an all-terrain vehicle or utility terrain vehicle without wearing protective headgear of the type required

under s.347.485 (1) (a) and with the chin strap properly fastened, unless the person is at least 18 years of age.

6. ATV Operators will have their headlights on while in use.

#### SECTION VII - ENFORCEMENT

This ordinance may be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the state of Wisconsin [and additionally as stated in the Town's citation authority ordinance adopted per s. 66.0113]

#### SECTION VIII - PENALTIES

The penalties under s. 23.33 (13) (a), Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

#### SECTION IX – SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

#### SECTION X – EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

Routes will be effective upon publication or posting and signage being put in place.

This ordinance is effective for one year from the date of signing and must be reviewed again by the town board and approved for continuance of the ordinance. Failure to review this ordinance shall cause it to no longer be valid after the one year from the initial signing of the ordinance.

The town clerk shall properly publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
