INCREASE SIZE OF BOARD TO FIVE MEMEBERS

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF PINE LAKE, ONIEDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN, HEREBY ORDAIN PURSUANT TO SECTION 60.21(1) WISCONSIN STATUTES AND HAVING VILLAGE POWERS INCREASE THE TOWN BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWN OF PINE LAKE, ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN FROM THREE(3) TO FIVE(5).

SECTION ONE: The Board hereby stagger the terms of its members so that the chairperson and 2 supervisors receiving the highest number of votesin the next election serve 2-year terms and the other 2 supervisors serve one-year terms, with each subsequent election to be 2-year terms so that elections occur in both odd-numbered and even-numbered years.

SECTION TWO; Said Ordinance is to take effect after its passage, posting in three (3) locations within the Township of Pine Lake, Oneida County, Wisconsin, which shall be recored in the office of the Town Clerk.
