TOWN OF PINE LAKE ORDINANCE TO REGULATE STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING OF VEHICLES (2024)

The Town Board of the Town of Pine Lake, Oneida County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.13, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:

- A. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on the following town highways in the Town of Pine Lake at any time:
 - a. River Road from CTH W to Sun Valley Road
 - b. Manor Road from River Road to 5223 Manor Road
 - c. Bozile Road
 - d. Lakeview Drive
 - e. The east side of Moen Lake Road 200 feet north and 200 feet south of the premises known as Billy and Mickey's Birchwood Lodge and Rustic Bar located at 3966 Moen Lake Road
 - f. Forest Lane from River Road to the Creek
 - g. Oak Drive from River Road to Plainview Road
- B. No person shall park or leave unattended any motor vehicle on any town road between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. from November 1st to April 1st in the Town of Pine Lake.
- C. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- D. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations.

Any person who fails to comply herewith shall have their car or vehicle towed away at owner's expense.

This ordinance is effective immediately upon posting. The town clerk shall properly post this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
