

SNOWMOBILE ROUTE ORDINANCE #17-01
TOWN OF PINE LAKE
COUNTY OF ONEIDA

Section I – Title and Purpose

The title of this ordinance is the Town of Pine Lake Snowmobile Route Ordinance #17-01. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish snowmobile routes in the town and to regulate the operation of snowmobiles in the town.

Section II – Authority

The town board has the specific authority to adopt this Snowmobile Route Ordinance under s.350.18, Wis. stats. and general authority under its village powers under s.60.22, Wis. stats.

Section III – Adoption of Ordinance

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates snowmobile routes in the town and provides for the regulation of the use of those routes.

Section IV – Designation of Snowmobile Routes

The following routes are designated snowmobile routes in the town:

- Black Bear Road
- Cross Country Road east of Highway 17
- Lakeshore Drive from Roosevelt Rd to 200 feet south of the railroad tracks
- Shady Lane
- Moen Lake Road
- North Limberlost Road
- Oak Leaf Road north of County C
- Pine Lake Road north of Spider Lake Road (until January 1st)
- River Road north of the dump road for ¼ mile
- Lake Thompson Road (both directions) from Town of Pelican to County C

Section V – Conditions Applicable to Snowmobile Routes

The following restrictions are placed on the use of the town snowmobile routes designated by this resolution during the following periods of the year:

- A. Town roads designated as snowmobile routes shall be marked with uniform snowmobile route signs in accordance with s.350.13, Wis. stats. No person may do any of the following in regard to signs marking town snowmobile routes.
 - a. Intentionally remove, damage, deface, move, or obstruct any uniform snowmobile route or trail sign or standard of the type established by the State of Wisconsin, Department of Natural Resources or intentionally interfere with the effective operation of any uniform snowmobile route or trail sign or standard if the sign or standard is legally placed by the state, any municipality or any authorized individual.
 - b. Possess any uniform snowmobile route or trail sign or standard of the type established by the State of Wisconsin, Department of Natural Resources for the warning, instruction, or information of the public, unless he or she obtained the uniform snowmobile route or trail sign or standard in a lawful manner. Possession of a uniform snowmobile route or trail sign or standard creates a rebuttable presumption of illegal possession.

- B. Operation shall be subject to all provisions of s.350.04(2), Wis. stats., and any other provision of Chapter 350, Wis. stats., which is adopted as part of this ordinance by reference, pursuant to s.350.18, Wis. stats.
- C. A copy of this ordinance shall be sent by the town clerk to the Oneida County Sheriff's Department.
- D. Additional restrictions
 - a. All snowmobile operators shall observe posted roadway speed limits.
 - b. All snowmobile operators shall ride single file.

Section VI – Enforcement

This ordinance may be enforced by any law enforcement office authorized to enforce the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

Section VII – Penalties

The penalties under S.350.11, Wis. stats., are adopted and incorporated by reference.

Section VIII – Severability


If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

Section IX – Effective Date


This ordinance is effective upon publication or posting.

The town clerk shall properly publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80, Wis. stats., and mail a copy to the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and to the Oneida County Sheriff's Department, as required under S.350.047 Wis. stats.


