TOWN OF PINE LAKE ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN TEMPORARY OPERATOR'S LICENSE ORDINANCE (2023)

- 1. **AUTHORITY:** Pursuant to s. 125.17 (4), Wis. Stats., the Town of Pine Lake, Oneida County, desires to establish standards under which a temporary operator's licenses may be issued.
- 2. **ELIGIBILITY**. A person who is 18 years of age either employed by or donating their services to the non-profit organization is eligible for a temporary operator's license. The applicant is not required to take the responsible beverage server training course.
- 3. **APPLICATION.** Application for a temporary operator's license shall be made to the town clerk on such form designated by the clerk and shall be accompanied by the fee.
- 4. CLERK OR DESIGNEE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE: A temporary operator's license may be issued to an applicant by the town clerk or the clerk's designee upon written application, subject to the provisions of this ordinance.
- 5. **TERM**. The temporary operator's license shall be valid from one to 14 days as indicated on the license from the date of issuance. No person may hold more than 2 (two) licenses of this kind per year.
- 6. **FEES**. The fee for a temporary operator's license is \$10.00.
