Chairman Jim Flory called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

- Discussion of bids for Spider Lake Road that were submitted and opened April 23, 2025, at the Highway Shop Committee meeting. Bids received were:
- Northeast Asphalt Base Bid \$346,732.20 and Alternate Bid #1 \$113,511.50
- 15 American Asphalt Base Bid \$333,044.59 and Alternate Bid #1 \$499,547.30
  - Musson Bros Inc Base Bid \$344,611.76 and Alternate Bid #1 \$108,543.50
  - Pitlik & Wick Inc Base Bid \$323,025.00 and Alternate Bid #1 \$105,434.00
  - Discussion of how to pay for part or all of the road work. Tim suggested that the town borrow \$200,000. The lowest total bid is Pitlik & Wick, Inc., for \$428,459. That would allow approximately \$40,000 for crack filling and leave \$32,000+for anything that may come up for road work. Another suggestion was to borrow \$225,000 to make sure that there is enough money and can be carried over to 2026 if not used. Further discussion. Motion by Ron Lueneburg to obtain a loan for \$225,000 to be used for road projects, second by Brian Gehrig. Motion carried by voice vote.
  - Motion by Jim Flory to accept the bid from Pitlik & Wick, Inc., for \$428,459 for both the Base Bid and the Alternate Bid #1, second by Tim Oestreich. Motion carried by voice vote.
  - Motion by Ron Lueneburg to adjourn, second by Jim Flory. Motion carried by voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 5:20 p.m.
